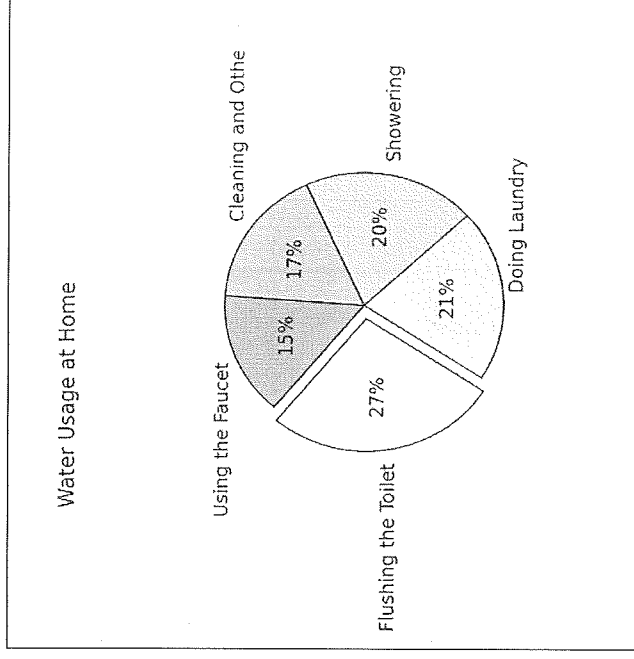

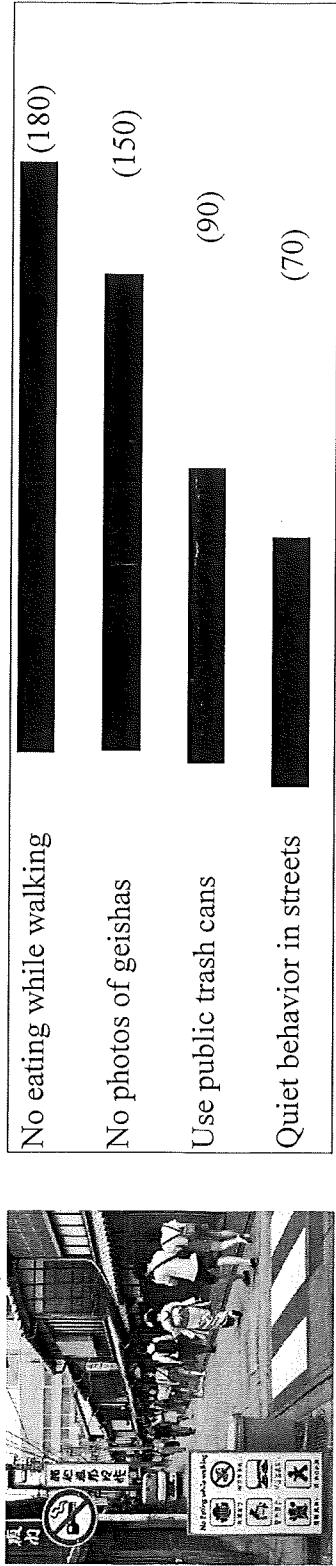

Kyoto's New Tourist Rules

Starting in April 2025, the city of Kyoto in Japan introduced new rules for tourists visiting traditional areas such as Gion. The government hopes to protect the local culture and improve the experience for both residents and visitors. A recent poll showed how tourists feel about these new rules. The chart below shows which new rules tourists support the most.

The most supported rule was “no eating while walking,” with 180 people agreeing it’s a good idea. “No photos of geishas” got 150 votes. Other rules like “use public trash cans” and “quiet behavior in streets” got fewer votes. Tourists said that these rules made the streets cleaner and helped protect Japanese traditions. One visitor said, “I don’t mind following the rules—respect is part of travel.”
