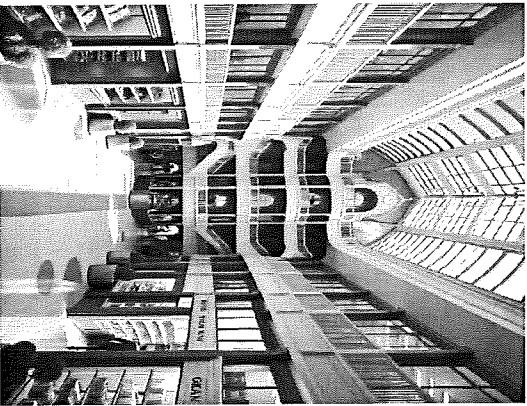

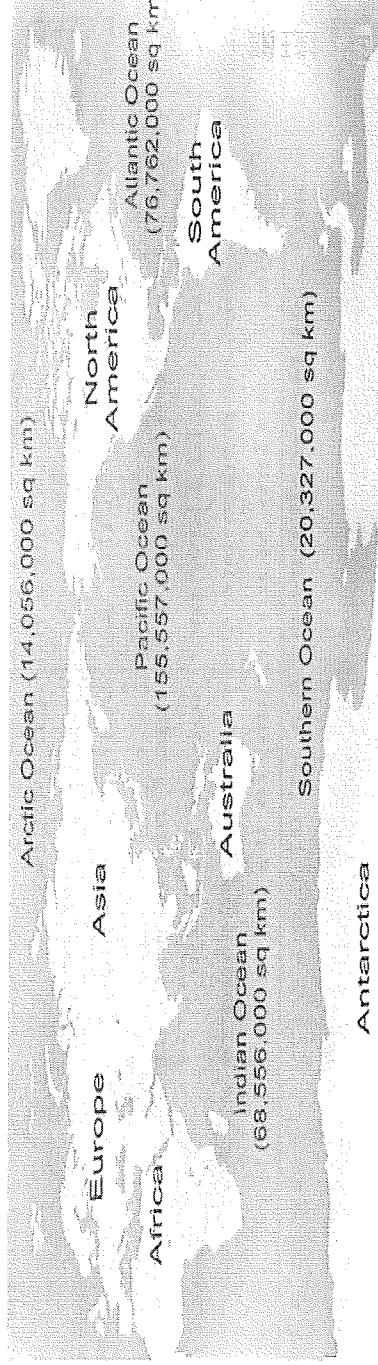

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Chart 2 shows that Taipei City had the highest life expectancy at 84.1 years, followed by New Taipei City, Taoyuan City, Taichung City, Tainan City, and Kaohsiung City. It also shows that average life expectancy **increased** from south to north.

There are some reasons for the rise of the average life expectancy in Taiwan, like good medical care, eating healthy and safe food, and exercise.
